Our Track Record

Phoenix Space currently supports **104** Palestinian students (and 13 of their dependents) evacuated from Gaza through tuition assistance, post-arrival support, and academic stabilisation.

Working alongside universities, NGOs, government partners and private sector donors, Phoenix Space helped mobilise funding, secure visa access, and coordinate safe educational pathways.
